**INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL**

**REPORT**

**Academic Year 2016-17**



A number of quality initiatives to promote quality culture have been taken by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell in the academic year 2016--2017. Notable among them are the following programme initiatives suggested by the IQAC-

1. As per the suggestion of IQAC, The Department of Assamese in collaboration with the Centre for Studies in Humanities, Assam organized a UGC sponsored National Seminar on 'Sahitya Kandari Padmanath Gohain Baruar Karma aru Sahityataji' held on 27-28 June, 2016 in the college premises. More than 100 scholars and college teacher presented their research papers in the seminar
2. As per the suggestion of IQAC, The Department of Philosophy in collaboration with Assam Gramin Vikash Bank, Guwahati organized a UGC sponsored National Seminar on Philosophy of Values: Its Relevance in Humanism on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2016
3. As per the suggestion of IQAC, The Dept. of Political Science, Karmashree Hiteswar Saikia College in collaboration with Srimanta Sankardev Kalakshetra organized a UGC sponsored National Seminar on 'Ethnic violence in North East India: Issues and Challenges' on 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> October, 2016. As many as 56 scholars presented their papers
4. As per the suggestion of IQAC, Uma Charan Bania Library and Education Center of the College in collaboration with Assam Library Association organized a UGC sponsored National Workshop on "Library in the Digital Environment" on 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2016 in the college premises.



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5. As per the suggestion of IQAC, the college adopted a village named Nam Tapesia of Sonapur Revenue Circle in Kamrup ( M) district as part of its Extension Service programme. Since then the college has been relentlessly working on the overall development of the village by organizing and arranging various camps, interactive sessions, activities and visits. Electrification of the Nam-Tepesia L. P. School has been taken up by the college. The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit and the Red Ribbon Club unit of the college have organized Special Camps in the village and delivered lectures on various socially relevant themes. Geography Dept. of the college has taken up a socio-economic survey of the adopted village.
6. As per the suggestion of IQAC, the NSS Unit has been carrying out various social service activities in and around Guwahati city. The unit publishes *The Sankalpa* which is the NSS mouthpiece, covering activities carried out during 2015-16
7. In view of the increasing numbers of road accident cases in the state, the IQAC suggested to take initiative in such issue and accordingly the college organized a talk on '*How to avoid accidents*' was delivered by Dr. Navanil Barua of GNRC, Guwahati to the students of the college.
8. As per the suggestion of IQAC, an Alumni meeting was held in the college auditorium on 2<sup>nd</sup> May, 2016 under the chairmanship of Dr. Sikhamoni Konwar, Principal of the college. It was decided to form an 'Alumni Association' to make a bridge between the college fraternity and the past students. Accordingly the association was formed with Ranjit Kumar Das as the President and Bhaskar Jyoti Das as the General Secretary.
9. As per the suggestion of IQAC, the second foundation day of the 'Information and Career Guidance Cell' of the college was held in the college auditorium on 19<sup>th</sup> August, 2016. On the occasion a talk was delivered by noted Psychiatrist Dr. Jayanta Das on the topic "*Mental Health in the Changing world*" which was attended by the distinguished guests, teaching staff and students of the college.



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10. As per the suggestion of IQAC, on the occasion of 100 years of Lokmanya Bal Gangadhar Tilak's Lion Roar 'Swarajya is my birth right and I shall have it', a talk was organized by the Department of History on 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2016. The lecture 'Balgangadhar Tilak: an Apostle of India's Struggle for Freedom' was delivered by Dr. Barnali Sarma, Associate professor in the Dept. of History, Gauhati University.
11. As per the suggestion of IQAC, a lecture on Comparative Literature' was organized in the college by the Department of English on 18<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2016. Prof. Dilip Borah, HOD, Department of Modern Indian Languages and Literary Study, Gauhati University had delivered the lecture.
12. As per the suggestion of IQAC, on 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2016, a lecture program was organized by the Department of Hindi on the importance of Hindi language. The talk was delivered by Dr. Narayan Talukdar on the topic "Hindi Bhasha Ke Upoyagita" who was the chief guest of the program.
13. As per the suggestion of IQAC, The Department of English organized a one week digital class workshop from 9<sup>th</sup> March 2017 to 14<sup>th</sup> March 2017 for the 6<sup>th</sup> semester major students.
14. It is envisaged that the students should be provided a firsthand learning experience through observation. Hence IQAC, suggested that field trips and educational tour should be organized by all the departments. Accordingly, the department of Assamese organized educational tour for the students to Battadruwa, Nagoan (Barduwa Than, the birth place of Srimanta Sankardeva) and the department of Education went to Sonapur.
15. For greater academic achievement in the classroom IQAC, suggested to organized parent teachers meet by all the departments. Accordingly the department of Assamese, Education and Economics organized the same .
16. As suggested by IQAC, all the departments conducted Extension Service to schools near the vicinity of the college. Classes were taken by the faculties of the



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various Departments in Baghatbai High School, Paniabari and in Ganesh Mandir High School, Sixmile Guwahati Assam.

17. The decision of purchasing required infrastructure and books in library was realized by acquiring infrastructure and books for the academic development of the institution.
18. As per suggestion by IQAC, for promoting research culture the teaching staff members published books and research articles in reputed journals.
